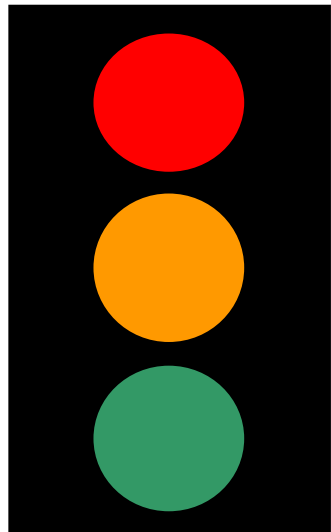


ATTENDANCE CHAMPIONS

The school's attendance champions were asked why attending school is important. This is what they said:

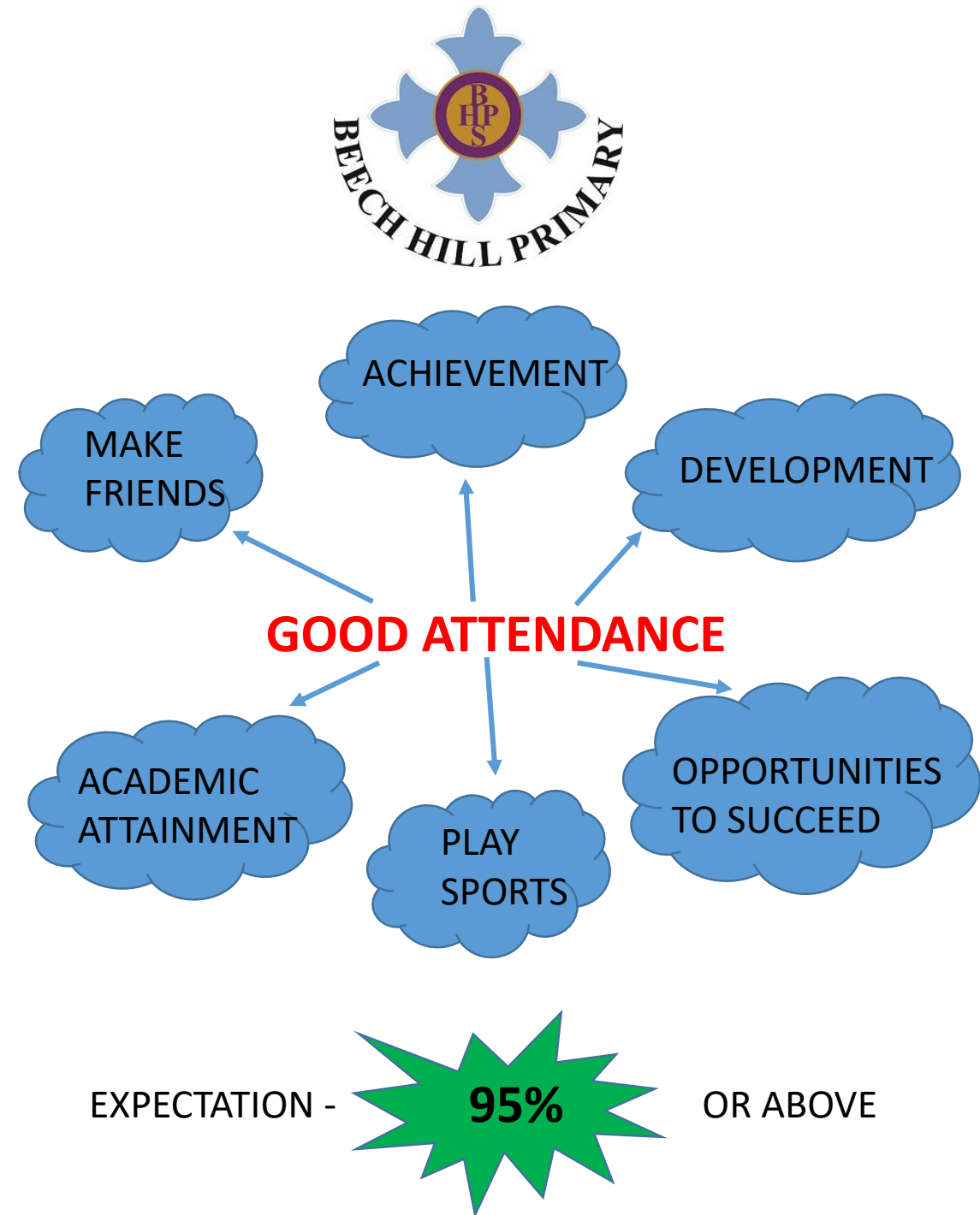
- Good attendance gives you a chance to win the movie/hot dog afternoon.

Red – Danger Zone - Below 90%

Amber – At Risk Zone – 90% - 94%

Green – Safety Zone – 95% - 100%
