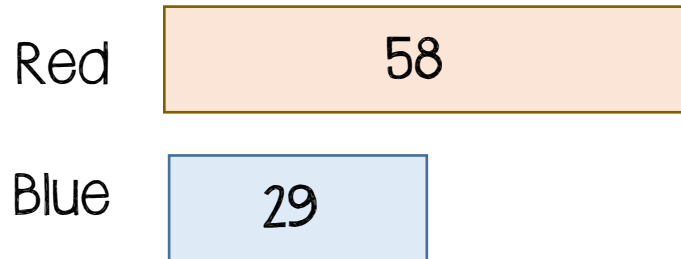


1 Mrs Jones has 58 red beads and 29 blue beads.
