Background knowledge

Joan Miró i Ferrà was a Spanish painter, sculptor, and ceramicist born in Barcelona. Joan Miró started painting when he was fourteen he attended an art school. He then started to develop his own style to draw scenes of trees and landscapes. In around the 1930s Joan started to make rapid changes to his style of painting. Influenced by Pablo Picasso, Miro developed more surrealist works.

What should I already know?

Line - A curved or straight mark made with a pencil or pen.

Pencil - A tool for drawing.

Shape - Lines that enclose a space eg, square, rectangles, circle.

Thickness - How wide or narrow a line is.
