# Background knowledge

Henri Matisse (31 December 1869 - 3 November 1954) was a French artist, known for both his use of colour and his fluid and original draughtsmanship. He was a <u>draughtsman</u> (technical drawings and calculations), <u>printmaker</u>, and <u>sculptor</u>, but is known primarily as a painter. Matisse is commonly regarded, along with <u>Pablo Picasso</u>, as one of the artists who best helped to define the revolutionary developments in the <u>visual arts</u> throughout the opening decades of the twentieth century, responsible for significant developments in painting and sculpture.
