Background knowledge

Henri Rousseau (21 May 1844 - 2 September 1910) was a French <u>post-impressionist</u> painter in the <u>Naïve</u> or <u>Primitive</u> manner. He was also known as Le Douanier (the customs officer), a humorous description of his occupation as a <u>toll and tax</u> collector. He started painting seriously in his early forties; by age 49, he retired from his job to work on his art full-time. [4]

Ridiculed during his lifetime by critics, he came to be recognized as a self-taught genius whose works are of high artistic quality. Rousseau's work exerted an extensive influence on several generations of <u>avant-garde</u> artists.
