I can name the capital of Spain immediately and three other well-known Spanish cities if I am given an opportunity to look at a map first. I can name one other country where they speak Spanish in the world. I can tell you my name, count to ten and how I am feeling in Spain with the help of an adult or the PowerPoint used in class. Exceeding: I can find Spain on a map of the world if an adult directs me to some of the surrounding countries. I can name the capital of Spain. I can name one other country where they speak Spanish in the world. I can tell you my name, count to ten and how I am feeling in Spanish when a teacher or an adult allows me to practise first and gives me a model answer.
